SECTION 2: HAZARD(S) IDENTIFICATION

- **Classification:**
 - Acute Toxicity, Inhalation (Category 4)
 - Skin/Eye Irritation (Category 2B)
 - Combustible Dust
- **Signal Word:** Warning
- **Hazard Statements:**
 - Harmful if inhaled or swallowed.
 - Dust may irritate eyes, skin, and lungs.

SECTION 3: COMPOSITION/INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

- **Barium Sulfate (CAS 7727-43-7):** 25–30%
- **TGIC (CAS 2451-62-9):** 1–10%
- *Note: Other ingredients are non-hazardous or withheld as trade secrets.*

SECTION 4: FIRST-AID MEASURES

- **Inhalation:** Move person to fresh air. Seek medical attention if breathing is difficult.
- **Skin Contact:** Wash with soap and water.
- **Eye Contact:** Flush eyes with clean water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present.
- **Ingestion:** Rinse mouth and drink water. Do not induce vomiting. Seek medical attention if symptoms persist.

- **Extinguishing Media:** CO2, water spray, or foam.
